- Nationally designated natural monument and symbol of Nago City
Hinpin Gajumaru (Old Banyan Tree)
This Hinpin Gajumaru is said to bring financial, competitive, and marital luck, and to ward off evil spirits. It's a famous spot in Nago!

Statue of Tei Junskou
Tei Junskou, a beloved leader of the Nago area, brought back a copy of the Six Classics in Morals from China, which later became widely used throughout Japan as a school textbook.
